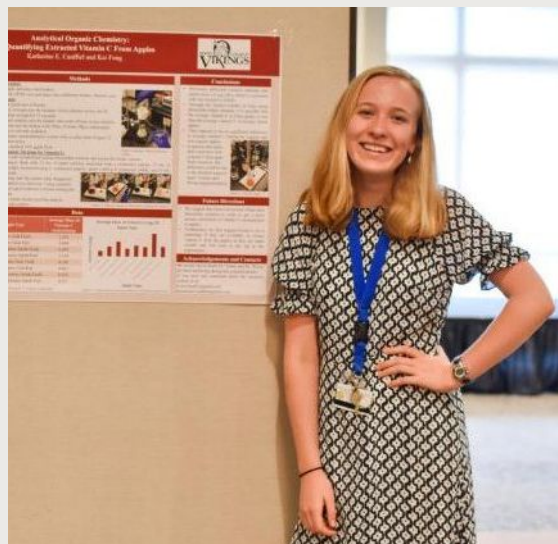

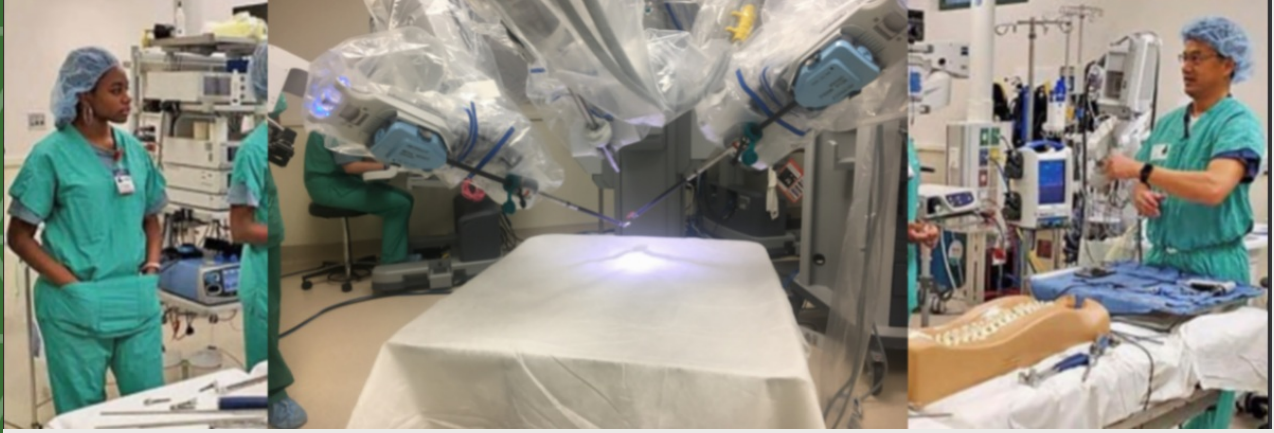
Governor's Honors Program


