HOPE/Zell Miller Scholarship

- Important: It is essential that students have their social security number on file; otherwise, they will not be eligible.
- How do confirm is Social Security number is on file? Students must create an account at www.ga-futures.org and check their HOPE GPA. (Freshmen will not have a HOPE GPA until spring semester). If students receive an error message, most likely the school does not have a copy of their social security card. Please email Mrs. LaRoy if this information needs to be updated.

Junior Advisement will run through the end of fall semester.

- The enrolling adult will receive an email in advance of the scheduled appointment
- Students will receive a message to their Office 365 account the Friday before their appointment as a reminder
- Additional junior advisement info will be shared via an Edmodo post
